<p>Algeria's Higher Education strategy on internationalisation focuses on the implementation of the Bologna three-cycle model of higher education, the creation of and co-operation between doctoral schools, and support for joint doctoral thesis projects. Supplementary changes and the completion of the reform at the doctoral level are expected to continue to facilitate international co-operation. It helps enhance elite training, develop academic and research co-operation, improve good governance and boost staff and students' mobility in respect for cultural diversity through various programmes (Tempus, Erasmus Mundus, Tassili, universities mutual agreements etc.).</p>
