## Communication „European higher education in the world”

A comprehensive internationalisation strategy should cover key areas grouped into the following three categories:

- ✓ international student and staff mobility;
- ✓ the internationalisation and improvement of curricula and digital learning;
- ✓ strategic cooperation, partnerships and capacity building.

These categories should not be seen as isolated but as integrated elements of a comprehensive strategy.

- ✓ to promote quality assurance and mutual recognition of qualifications;
- ✓ to attract talent and deepen partnerships;
- ✓ to enhance the international experience, intercultural competence and employability of graduates.
