<p>In preparation by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education</p> <p>The Ministry of Science and Higher Education, together with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Foundation for the Development of the Education System and the Conference of Rectors of Academic Schools in Poland, initiated in spring 2012 the campaign "Ready, Study, Go! Legislation on joint degrees		
<p>Issuing of joint diplomas is possible according to the law on higher education.</p> <p>Pursuant to Article 168 of the Act of 27 July 2005, the Law on Higher Education, degree programmes of the first and second cycle as well as long cycle may be provided jointly by various higher education institutions, including foreign and other academic or research institutions on the basis of an agreement concluded between them. Such an agreement may specify the fields and cycles of degree programmes to be provided jointly; however Polish academic units which are parties to the agreement, shall be required to have an authorization for the provision of degree programmes at cycles corresponding to those included in the agreement.</p> <p>Graduates of the above programmes may be awarded a joint diploma in compliance with the requirements laid down in Regulation of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of 11 September 2011.</p> <p>Pursuant to art. 14a of the Act of 14 March 2003 on Academic Degrees and Academic Title and Degrees and Title in Art joint doctoral studies may be conducted together with foreign institution (having rights to award doctoral degree) on the basis of an agreement concluded between them. Upon completion of these studies a graduate receives joint diploma which template should be defined in the agreement on joint doctoral studies implementation mentioned above, in compliance with the requirements laid down in Regulation of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of 22 September 2011.</p>
